PLEASE BRING:

- Paints: an Introductory Set of Watercolors- tubes or pans, 6-12 colors.
 - Suggested Sets: <u>QoR Watercolors, Cotman, Cotman with Pallette, Daler-Rowney with Palette</u>
- Paper:
 - o 140 lb cold press Watercolor Paper:
 - o Pad: 9 x 12 inches, 12 sheets -OR- 2 individual sheets
 - Suggested Brand: Arches
- **Brushes:** Between 3 to 4 Watercolor brushes of various sizes and shapes
 - o Suggested Shapes: Round, Filbert, Oval Wash. See a brush set here.
- Palette with wells for mixing (Unless your set comes with a palette)
- Pencils: 2H and/or 4H
 - o **Suggested Brands:** Staedtler Mars, Pentel, Faber-Castell
- Eraser: white plastic or vinyl
 - Suggested Brands: These are very inexpensive and work well.

Other Optional Materials:

- Paper Towels
- Extra soft tissues
- Container for water
- Container or bag for all supplies
