### *Is This Thing On?* | Feb. 4 and 6

Directed by Bradley Cooper, 2025, USA, Rated R, 121 min.



This heartfelt comedy-drama stars Will Arnett and Laura Dern as Alex and Tess Novak, a long-married couple navigating an amicable separation while co-parenting and re-discovering themselves. When Alex stumbles into New York's stand-up comedy scene as a way to process his emotional upheaval, the couple's evolving dynamic becomes both humorous and tender. Featuring Bradley Cooper in a supporting role as well, the film premiered as the

Closing Night selection at the 2025 New York Film Festival. Critics praised its warmth and relatability, with the *Rotten Tomatoes* consensus calling it "another terrific relationship study" and *The New Yorker* describing it as "a charming and introspective comedy that delves into emotional aftermath with dry humor."

### *The Secret Agent* | Feb. 11 and 13

Directed by Kleber Mendonça Filho, 2025



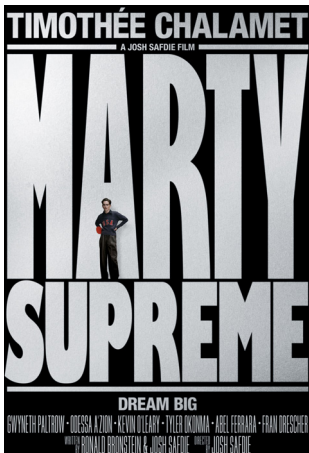
Brazil/France/Germany/Netherlands, Not Rated, 158 min., subtitled

This neo-noir historical thriller follows Armando (Wagner Moura), a former professor and technology expert caught in the brutality of Brazil's 1977 military dictatorship, as he attempts to flee persecution and reunite with his son in Recife. Featuring a sprawling international ensemble including Tânia Maria, Maria Fernanda Cândido, and Udo Kier, the film blends suspense,

political urgency, and intimate family drama. *The Secret Agent* was the most awarded film at the 2025 Cannes Film Festival and went on to garner multiple Golden Globe wins as well as Academy Award nominations.

### *Marty Supreme* | Feb. 18 and 20

Directed by Josh Safdie, 2025, USA, Rated R, 150 min.



Timothée Chalamet stars as Marty Mauser, a charismatic but self-destructive shoe salesman in 1950s New York whose obsessive pursuit of becoming the world's greatest table tennis champion propels him into a frenetic world of hustling, chaos, and unexpected emotional stakes. Featuring Gwyneth Paltrow, Odessa A'zion, Kevin O'Leary, Tyler the Creator, and Fran Drescher, the film premiered at the 2025 New York Film Festival before its nationwide release. *Marty Supreme* earned wide critical acclaim and

numerous awards season nods—including Academy Award nominations—and was named a Top Ten Film of 2025 by both the National Board of Review and the American Film Institute.

### *Hamnet* | Feb. 25 and 27

Directed by Chloé Zhao, 2025, UK/USA, Rated PG-13, 126 min.



Adapted from Maggie O'Farrell's acclaimed novel, *Hamnet* tells the deeply moving story of William Shakespeare (Paul Mescal) and his wife Agnes (Jessie Buckley) as they confront the devastating death of their young son, Hamnet—the tragedy that would later inspire *Hamlet*. Emphasizing emotional intimacy and human truth over grand theatrics, the film weaves lush period detail with a contemporary sensibility. *Hamnet* won the People's Choice Award at the 2025 Toronto

International Film Festival, an honor often seen as an indicator for Oscar recognition. *The Guardian* called it "a profoundly affecting portrait of grief and love, led by powerhouse performances from Buckley and Mescal."
